#### **CLASS R1**

Recently, we began to learn what **working as a team** looks like. Through modelling, the children are observing collaborative work in a team of two and practising this with learning partners.



#### CLASS 2E

In 2E, as part of our English lessons we have been investigating a crime committed by **Goldilocks** and made some **wanted posters.** 



Southwark Cathedral and made candles and candle holder which we plan to paint as part of our art lessons. Our new topic is 'Seaside' and we have been thinking about what we might find and what we might do at the seaside. In Maths we have been investigating length and measuring our jumps using meter sticks. In science, design technology and PSHE we will be learning about different types of food and how they affect our health.





#### **CLASS 4G**

In year four for science, we have been learning about the **digestive system.** We have learnt the different organs which make up the digestive system and its function. Matching different parts of the digestive system with their function has helped us to deepen our understanding of how our bodies digest food.

In Writing, we are working on a new book called **Varmints**. This story has

helped us to learn more about the importance of the envi-

ronment and keeping it safe. We are learning how to use **personification** within our writing and using the correct adjectives and verbs to describe and specify.





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
