## FROM AROUND THE SCHOOL

#### **ART**

Year 1 have been studying the artist **Giuseppe Arcimboldo**, who was famous for doing portraits using fruit and vegetables .This week they will be using paints to draw their own portraits

Year 2's topic is **the seaside** so they've enjoyed drawing different seaside scenes. They have gone on to doing a collage of items that you find at the seaside— beach balls, buckets, and spades, sea-



gulls, lighthouses ,to name but a few.



Year 5's topic is **rivers**. Children have been studying the artist **Monet** they some wonderful pictures using chalk

and oil pastels as well as making a 3D model of a waterway.

Year 6 have been learning about the **Benin bronzes.** They have drawn some detailed pictures but they have also used clay and plasticine to make 2D versions of bronzes. finishing off with some of them being painted in metallic colours such as bronze and gold making them look more realistic.



#### PE

#### **CLASS 1K**

In 1K this week we have been reading **The Billy and The Beast** story. The children had the opportunity to design wanted posters, send emails, write character descriptions and recipes. They have also acted out the story in role of the different characters in the story.



In maths, we have been learning to recognise and know the **value of different coins** and solve simple practical problems in the context of money.

In RE, we have been reading Bible stories about the miracles that Jesus performed. We learnt how Jesus showed his pow-

er when he calmed the wind and the waves. We also learnt about how he showed his love for sick people when he cured a man who was paralysed.
