Where possible, all of your child's learning will be linked to this subject. Below is a topic map outlining the areas of learning we intend to cover this term. Homework will be set every **Monday** on MS Teams and other websites such as MyMaths or Purple Mash. Thank you.

#### **MATHS**

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge, including:

- Finding factors of numbers
- Read, write, compare and order numbers within 5,000,000
- Number and place value
- Decimals and place value
- Addition subtraction/multiplication/division using formal methods

#### **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

In RE our topic is the **Kingdom of God.** Over the term we will be reflecting on the values of the Kingdom and the importance of them in our world. How the values are used and who is invited into the Kingdom. We will look at the miracles of Jesus and how he showed compassion to others. We will think of ways that we can show compassion to others.

#### COMPUTING

Computing this term will be closely linked to our topic work. Children will learn how best to use a computer for research purposes and how to find trustworthy information and use them to take notes. These skills will be used to help create our own fact files on given tasks.

# **Battle of Britain**

## **Autumn Term 1**



#### **MUSIC**

This half term, we will be learning about the Ragtime composer Scott Joplin and features of Ragtime music and learning to perform simple chord sequences to accompany a Ragtime tune.

#### SCIENCE

This term our topic will be starting with classification. Under this topic we will look at how animals and plants are sorted into families by looking at similarities and differences.



## HISTORY - GEOGRAPHY

Our topic this half term is Battle of Britain. We will be comparing rural and urban areas those evacuees were sent to and looking at the difference and experiences that they had. We will be plotting, using atlases, the countries that took part in World War 2 and place in Britain that were affected by bombs. We would also be focusing on a theme for **Black History Month**.

### WRITING AND READING

Throughout this term the texts we will be reading are:

#### The Journey - Whole school book

We are starting the school year with a whole school text that has themes of community, friendship and coming together.

#### **Hugo Cabret by Brian Selznick**

This teaching sequence is based upon 'The Invention of Hugo Cabret' by Brian Selznick. Children will learn and revise many of the key grammar requirements of Y6 and have the opportunity to apply them by writing a missing flashback chapter exploring Hugo's experience of living Uncle Claude, as well as researching about the famous film director George Méliès and writing a biography and letters.

#### ART AND DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

We will study Henry Moore and his works. This will be linked to our topic. It will include sketches from the Battle of Britain period. We will be recreating Henry Moore sketches from evacuees in the London Underground.

#### **PSHE**

In PSHE, we will begin learning about Growth Mindset and learn about the brain in Mind Up.

#### SPORTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

This term's focus is multi ability skills. This includes cognitive skills. The children will evaluate strengths and weaknesses to read and react to different game situations
