MATHS

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge.

- Measurement: Telling the time to the nearest minute. Roman numerals and solving problems involving money. Length and perimeters.
- Addition and subtraction.
- Data handling.
- Multiplication and division.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE, we will be learning about **Trust in God**. We will begin the topic learning about the prophets and their message. We will discuss the annunciation to Mary, the Holy Trinity and the mystery of the Incarnation. To recognise and live out the message of Christmas we will plan a project to raise money for a charity. We will learn about how people in the Bible trusted in God.

We will also be learning about other faiths, particularly **JUDAISM**.



COMPUTING

Computing this term will be closely linked to our topic work. Children will learn how best to use a computer for research purposes and how to find trustworthy information and to take notes. These skills will be used to help create our own Stone Age fact files.

HISTORY - GEOGRAPHY

Our topic this half term is 'I am a warrior'. We will be comparing Britain and Italy. Their maps, location, knowledge and human and physical geography.

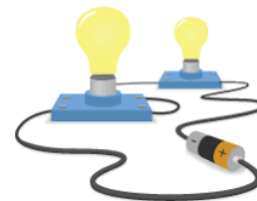


MUSIC

FRENCH

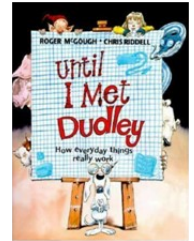
Unit 8: Quelle heure est-il?

WRITING AND READING

Throughout this term we will be reading 'Until I met Dudley' by Roger McGough to inspire our reading and writing.

Explanation text (formal and informal) Children will write their own explanation texts for everyday electrical objects, inventing their own imaginary responses to the question of how they work.

Letter Writing – Children will write letters to fictional characters to find out how some appliances work. 'Stickman' – By Julia Donaldson



ART AND DESIGN

Painting: We will experiment with different effects and textures including different thickness of paint, scratches & splashes. Mix primary and secondary colours and use shades to closely match colours of objects

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

As part of our work in Literacy on the book **Until I Met Dudley**, we will be inventing and making our own appliances using recyclable materials.

SPORTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

This term's focus is on social skills that—learning to organise roles and guiding others. we will develop our confidence in in bench balls and end balls games.
