MATHS

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge.

- **Fractions**, recognise and show simple equivalent fractions of a half, find unit fractions of a number1/3 of 36=12
- Measurement/ Time, tell and write the time to the nearest 5 Minutes
- Solve problems related to time
- Addition and subtraction using the expanded written method.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE we will be learning about **The Mass.** We will learn about the key parts of The Mass such as the beginning



of Mass, the readings, what happens at Holy Communion and the significance of the Last Supper.

COMPUTING

In Computing, we will be working on we will complete our unit on Coding and then learning about using spreadsheets. Both of these will be taught using PurpleMash.

In PHSE we will be continuing or focus on **growth mindset**. In Mind Up, we will be focusing on appreciating happy experiences and choosing optimism.


HISTORY - GEOGRAPHY
