

### **MATHS**

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge.

- Consolidating mixed numbers and improper fractions.
- Rounding decimal numbers to two decimal place.
- Understanding percentages and record as fractions and decimals.
- Mental multiplication and division and problem solving involving decimals and money.
- Calculate perimeter of shapes and areas of rectangles and squares.
- Statistics: Finding information in line graphs

### **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

Our RE topic is **RECONCILIA-TION.** We will understand that actions have consequences. We will know about God's love and forgiveness; understand the meaning of sin; reflect on how the sacraments help us.; and reflect on what it means to experience forgiveness.



### COMPUTING

In Computing this term, we will learn how to create spreadsheets and use analytical software on Purple Mash.

**HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY** 

In History and Geography this term, we will be exploring the impact of the invasions of the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings in England. We will explore trade, travel and the beginning of laws in England during this period. We will also go on a trip to the British Museum to find out about Sutton Hoo!

# Anglo Saxons & Vikings Spring Term 2



### **MUSIC**

We will be learning about composers from around the world. We will focus on interlocking melodies and polyrhythmic phrases to compose a piece.

### **SCIENCE**

This term our topic will be learning about **Animals including humans:** we will plan scientific enquiries to answer questions on human development from birth to old age.



The scientific skills we will use are: recording data using diagrams and labels, classification keys and tables.

### WRITING AND READING

In DT, we will research and produce

### **FRENCH**

In French, we will learn vocabulary and phrases linked to holidays.
