MATHS

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge.

- Recognise place value in teen numbers and in two-digit numbers beyond 20
- Solve simple one-step word problems (including in the context of money), involving addition and subtraction
- Use **arrays** to support early multiplication and division
- Tell the time **to the hour** and **half past the hour** using the clock face
- Recognise, find and name a **quarter** as one of four

MUSIC

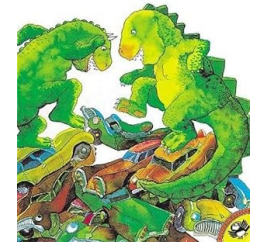
Musical patterns

WRITING AND READING

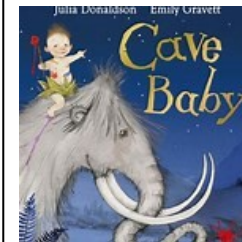
Throughout this term we will be reading the following stories 'Cave Baby' by Julia Donaldson 'Dinosaurs and all that Rubbish' by Michael Foreman

SCIENCE
