This curriculum overview gives an outline of the areas of learning we intend to cover in Summer 1 (April – May). **MATHS**

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge. The children will also have their SATS in May so please keep checking MyMaths.

- The children will begin with Number and Place Value: They will be learning to partition numbers into different combinations of tens and ones.
- Multiplication and Division: Recalling facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times table; solving word problems and learning about odd and even numbers
- Fractions: Finding  $1/2$ ,  $1/4$ ,  $2/4$ ,  $3/4$  and  $1/3$  of a number or shape; solving word problems
- Addition and subtraction.

**RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

In RE we will be learning about **Easter tide**:

The children will be learning about what happened on Easter Sunday; when Jesus appeared to his disciples when they were fishing; the story of Jesus' Ascension and the story Pentecost. In May we will also be celebrating the school's Patronal Feast—the feast of The English and Welsh Martyrs.



**COMPUTING**

**Purple Mash unit 2.4** -Children learn about the importance of phrasing questions and that certain resources are limited in the answers they can provide.

**HISTORY**

In History, the children will be learning all about the **Great Fire of London**. The children will be learning about: what caused the Great Fire of London; the main historical figure involved in the fire and how London in 1666 compared to the London we live in today.

**MUSIC**

In Music, we will be learning about Music from the time of the Great Fire of London. We will also be singing in rounds, rhyming and composing tunes with simple words



**SCIENCE**

This term our topic will be learning about **Animals including Humans**.

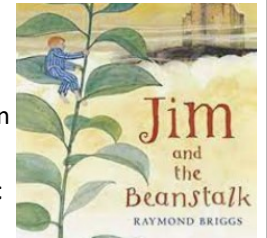
The children will be learning about how animals and humans grow and develop: This will include learning about the life cycles of animals such as Frogs and Caterpillars. The children will also be learning about keeping healthy including eating a varied and balanced diet.

**WRITING AND READING**

The children will be reading the book **Jim and the Beanstalk** by Raymond Briggs.

The children will be writing dialogue, letters and finally writing their own version of the story. After 'Jim and the Beanstalk', we will be doing work based on **The Great Fire of London** by Emma Adams. This will link perfectly with our history topic based on the Great Fire of London.

For Reading, children will be reading **Beaver Towers** by Nigel Hinton. The children will be: Summerising; inferring; predicting and retrieving information from the text.



**ART AND DESIGN**

In Art, the children will be looking at **cityscapes**. In We will learn about colour mixing and be building up to producing our own work inspired by the work of the fauvists such as Andre Derain and Henri Matisse.

**PSHE**

This term's focus is SRE (Sex and Relationship Education). We will be learning about differences between male and female bodies and naming different body parts. We would be carrying on with the Mindup curriculum.

**SPORTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

This term's focus is **Games**
