**MATHS**

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge.

- Length and perimeters.
- Addition and subtraction.

**RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

In RE, we will be learning about **Trust in God**. We will begin the topic learning about the prophets and their message. **MUSIC**

**SCIENCE**

This term our topic will be **Electricity**, identifying common appliances and creating simple circuits. We will record our results and draw conclusions from our results. We will explore and identify common conductors and insulators. We will carry out investigations on how bulbs can get brighter.

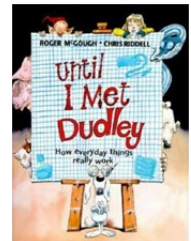


**WRITING AND READING**

Throughout this term we will be reading 'Until I met Dudley' by Roger McGough to inspire our reading and writing.
