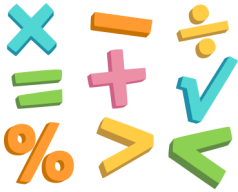

MATHS

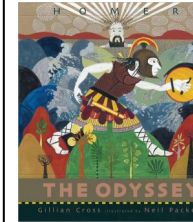
In our Maths learning this term, we will start off with building on our percentages knowledge from Year 4 and we will learn how to find percentages of amounts. We will then consolidate our understanding of telling the time by applying this skill to reading timetables. Alongside this learning, we will continuously review our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills. At the end of the term, we will return to geometry and position and direction.

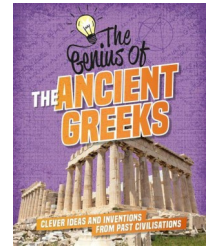
Year Five ANCIENT GREEKS Autumn Term 2

WRITING AND READING



In Writing this term, we will be inspired by Gillian Cross' retelling of The Odyssey, which is an epic adventure poem, involving many battles and monsters! As we build up to writing our own epic adventure story at the end of the term, we will write persuasive speeches, diary entries and dialogue.

We will be focusing on adverbials of manner, abstract nouns, prepositions, the correct punctuation of dialogue, parenthesis and powerful verbs. In Reading, we will start the term off with a nonfiction text called The Genius of Ancient Greece and then will read The Odyssey in our Destination Reader lessons.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION



In RE we will be learning about **JUDAISM** as part of Other Faiths Week. We will then be learning about God's Covenants in the Old Testament and we will explore

God's New Covenant with us, and how God guides and challenges his people.



MUSIC

This half term, we will be learning about traditional songs from around the world. We will focus on the awareness of melodic and rhythmic phrases within a song as well as **focusing on Christmas Celebrations**.

SCIENCE



In Science, we will be studying Living things and their habitats. We will study the lifecycles of flowers and fruit and vegetables as well as learning about the lifecycles of animals and insects. We will learn about David Attenborough's contributions to science.

COMPUTING



In Computing, we will continue to use PurpleMash as our platform for developing our word processing and database skills.

HISTORY - GEOGRAPHY



Our topic this half term is **Ancient Greece** and we will develop our historical thinking firstly by examining how the geography of the Greek islands affected their history, before learning to think like an archaeologist. Finally, we will debate whether Athens or Sparta was the strongest kingdom.

PSHE

In PSHE, as well as continuing our Mindfulness curriculum with MindUp, we will also be marking Parliament Week and Anti-Bullying Week. We will also be continuing with our financial awareness learning with LifeSavers.



DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY



Building on our science learning about mechanisms, in DT, we will answer the question, "How can we create a carousel?". We will evaluate existing carousel toys, design, make and finally evaluate our own creation.

SPORTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION



This term in PE, we will be developing a range of multi-skills and coordination as well as developing our fitness and applying to games such as football.
