MATHS

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge including:

- **Calculation** - which includes division, multiplication and fractions.
 - **Geometry** - working on angles and shapes
 - **Algebra, Ratio and proportion**
 - **Statistics** (data handling and graphs)
 - **Measurement**, including length, mass, area etc
 - **Fractions** (including decimals, and percentages)
- Consolidating understanding of all topics.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE we will be learning about **Jesus the Messiah**. We will be learning about who Jesus is and why he is called the 'Messiah'.

As we approach Easter we will reflect on this important time in the Christian calendar and look at each day of Holy Week in depth.



SCIENCE

Light

In this topic we will be looking at light. We will be learning about how light travels, what is a reflection and how people see.

We will be building our understanding of white light and how it is made up of the different colours. We will be doing investigation to show this.

HISTORY / GEOGRAPHY

Our topic this half term is **'Victorian Era and the Impact of the Industrial Revolution in Britain and the World'**. We will be looking at the causes and effects of the Revolution on society. Also the resulting changes in society.

MUSIC

Medieval Music

Our music lessons this half term will include learning about authentic instruments and their use; Exploring plainchant as a style of music and form of notation; composing simple melodies of around 5 notes; recognise different forms of notation including neumes as a precursor to staff notation serves different purposes.

PHSE

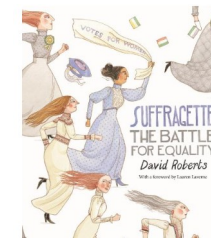
Mind up—developing our skills and our understanding how our brain works. Looking at strategies to help our manage our emotions.
