
WRITING AND READING



In Writing this term, we will be inspired by Gillian Cross' retelling of The Odyssey, which is an epic adventure poem, involving many battles and monsters! As we build up to writing our own epic adventure story at the end of the term, we will write persua-

sive speeches, diary entries and dialogue.

We will be focusing on adverbials of manner, abstract nouns, prepositions, the correct punctuation of dialogue, parenthesis and powerful verbs. In Reading, we will start the term off with a nonfiction text called 'The Genius of Ancient Greece' and then will read 'The Odyssey' in our Destination Reader lessons.
