MATHS

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge.

- Learning about place value and ordinal numbers.
- We will be ordering and solving missing number problems.
- Adding and subtracting using number tracks and solving worded problems.
- Describe and sort 2D and 3D shapes.
- Describe position direction and movement of objects and people.
- Solve problems involving number pairs to 10 and number pairs to 20

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE we will be learning about Families and celebrations.

The children will learn about:

- The presentation of Jesus to the temple as a baby.
- Jesus and his Family
- Jesus in the temple.
- Our Church family.

COMPUTING

MUSIC

This half term, we will be learning about **Musical Characters**, choosing sounds to represent ideas and different moods.

SCIENCE

This term our topic will be **Animals including Humans**. We will be naming and grouping common animals and identifying different parts of the body.

We will also be looking at seasonal changes that occur during winter.



GEOGRAPHY



Our topic this half term is 'China' and we will be comparing the UK with China using maps and globes. We will compare and contrast the food, weather, landmarks and lifestyle of the two countries. The end of the topic will result in a China experience day in school.

WRITING AND READING

Throughout this term, we will be reading stories and writing our own versions:

We will be acting out and retelling stories. Writing our own version of a story.

We will be writing in role, creating guides and fact files.

ART AND DESIGN

In Art, the children will be looking at the artist Vincent Van Gogh- Starry, Starry Night- Use a variety of tools for example different brush sizes and types. The children will be naming and mixing the primary colours. Create textured paint eg by adding sand.

PSHE

Children would be exploring how parts of the body grow and change. They would be learning about keeping clean. They would be learning about Mindful Breathing and tasting. We will also explore money in our lifesavers lessons and explore our rights through RRS lessons.

SPORTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

This term's focus is on the cognitive skills of following rules and naming things they can do. To throw and catch successfully while on the move and sending and receiving a ball with a partner.
