MATHS

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge.

- Number and Place Value
- Addition: Adding two, three digit numbers together
- Subtraction: Subtracting two, three digit numbers
- Geometry: 3D shapes and properties
- Multiplication: Focus on the x2, x4 and x8 tables.
- Division: Division for x8 table and remainders

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE, we will be learning about the **Sacrament of Reconciliation**, understand what it means to make wrong choices and reflect on how wrong choices affect us and other people.

We will also reflect on God's love and forgiveness, and what it means to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

COMPUTING

Computing this term will be using PurpleMash and learning about spreadsheets. We will be learning about using formulae in spreadsheets and using spreadsheets to solve real-world problems.

HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY

Our topic this half term is '**Tribal Tales**' and children will be learning about looking at prehistoric Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. They will be introduced to the life of a Stone Age child. We will be looking at where they lived and what they ate. How the Stone Age people progressed to the Iron Age. In geography ,we will be looking at the settlements including the different types of settlement such as cities and villages.

MUSIC

Melodies and Drones

Listening to a variety of music using drones.
Performing and composing simple melodies and combining with drone accompaniments.
Learning songs and learning drone accompaniments.

SCIENCE

This term our topic will be **Rocks** we will ask questions which will be answered by planning and conducting a fair test. We will be comparing and grouping rocks.



WRITING AND READING

Throughout this term we will be reading the '**The Pied Piper**' by the Brothers Grimm to inspire our writing and '**The First Drawing**' by Mordicai Gerstein. For reading, our focus is on **Anna Hibiscus** by Atinuke and Amazing Creatures which is an Information Text.



Our main coverage for writing will be a focus on **Newspaper report writing** - We will be teaching skills for reported speech and text layout.

Story writing—based on our topic for this half term. The children will practise fronted adverbials and speech.

ART AND DESIGN

We will be looking at the artist J M W Turner and our focus will be on printmaking. We will use polystyrene tiles and creating block prints.

FRENCH

We will be learning the names for parts of the body and learning the days of the week.

PSHE

In PHSE, we will be continuing with the MindUp curriculum. We will begin with '**Perspective Taking**' and move on to '**Choosing Optimism**'.

We will also be continuing with our focus on 'Growth mindset.'

SPORTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

This term's focus is on **sending skills (using hands)**. Children will learn how to safely move into a space after passing a ball. They will be learning how to receive and catch a ball from rebound.
