MATHS

This term we will be learning about division including dividing numbers on a number line and solving missing number problems. We will also be using our division skills with fractions when we learn about finding $1/2$, $1/4$, $2/4$, $3/4$ and $1/3$ of a number.

We will be learning about money and seeing what different combinations of coins we can find that add up to different totals.

We will continue to learn to tell the time to the nearest fifteen minutes (o'clock, quarter past, half past and quarter to)

We will learn about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes including identifying right angles.

MUSIC

In music, we will be studying music which accompany stories including Peter and the Wolf and the Hare and the Tortoise.

We will also be learning about creating mood and atmosphere through music.

SCIENCE


This term our topic will be **plants**. We will be investigating what plants need to grow and stay healthy. We will compare plants that have been grown from a bulb and ones which have been grown from a seed. As part of our science, we will also be planting vegetables and observing how they grow under different conditions.



WRITING AND READING

To start the half-term will be reading The Minpins by Roald Dahl, where we will be writing diary entries, character descriptions, letters and stories.

We will also be using our learning in science when we read Jim and the Beanstalk where we will again be writing letters and diary entries. We will also be writing instructions on how to plant a bean plant.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE, we will be learning about the season of Lent.

We will be learning about the events of Holy Week and deepen our understanding of God's forgiveness.



We will explore the theme of reconciliation and learn about the steps involved in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

This term in DT we will be designing and then making our own fairground wheel. Then we will evaluate and discuss how to improve the design.

GEOGRAPHY

Our topic this half term continues to be 'Going Green.' The children will continue to learn about the UK's landmarks and features as well as some amazing places around the world. We will also learn about our local area and how we can look after natural habitats.



COMPUTING

In computing, we will be learning how information from questioning can be presented using a computer. To make information clearer and easier to understand.

PHYSICAL, SOCIAL, HEALTH EDUCATION

This half term, we will be beginning our SRE unit where we will learn how we are growing and learning in diverse communities that are God given. We will also continue our Life Savers curriculum and focus on mind-up.

SPORTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

In PE, we will be focusing on learning basic dribbling techniques and games that teach us multiple skills.
