MATHS

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge.

- Recognise place value in teen numbers and in two-digit numbers beyond 20
- Solve simple one-step word problems (including in the context of money), involving addition and subtraction
- Use **arrays** to support early multiplication and division
- Tell the time **to the hour** and **half past the hour** using the clock face
- Recognise, find and name a **quarter** as one of four

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE we will be learning about **The Resurrection**
The children will learn about:

- The resurrection of Jesus
- Jesus appears to the disciples
- Jesus eats with the disciples
- Jesus and Thomas
- Jesus returns to heaven



COMPUTING

Animated bible stories
(children will be creating their own animated bible stories using Purple Mash.)

HISTORY

Our topic this half term is 'Dinosaurs and Cavemen' and we will be learning about life in the stone age. Children will be asking and answering questions about the past. They will use different sources to make conclusions about past events. The children will have a chance to carry out research using books, photos and the internet.

Drug Education

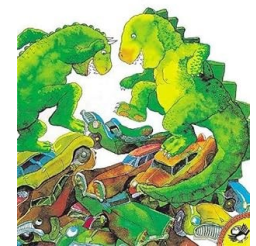
Explore substances and situations that are safe or unsafe.

WRITING AND READING

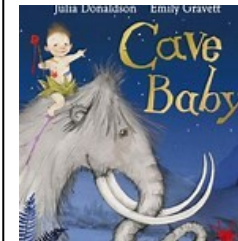
Throughout this term we will be reading the following stories

ART AND DESIGN

In Art the children will be using mixed media to Collage-Collect, sort & group media in different ways eg colour/texture. They will arrange & glue materials to backgrounds and give reasons for their choices.

LIFESAVERS

Children will be looking at how to look after their money. They will learn that they need to look after their money and can choose a safe place to keep money. They will be beginning to understand the consequences of losing money and how that might make them feel.

SPORTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

This term's focus is on athletics. The children will develop their movement dexterity.
