**MATHS**

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge. We will begin by learning about **number and place value** where we partition three digit numbers and also order and compare numbers. We will then move on to **addition and subtraction and multiplication** where we consolidate our skills using formal written methods. This half term we will also be learning about the **properties of 2D shapes** including parallel and perpendicular lines.

Singing rounds and maintaining their own part when supported by an adult.



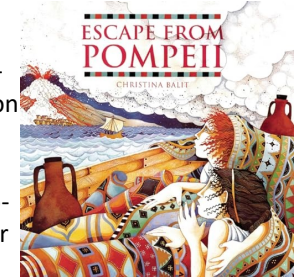
**SCIENCE**

Our main topic this term will be **Light**. The children will find out the different sources of light and the importance of light for helping us to see. . We will also be learning about how shadows are formed and why these have different sizes



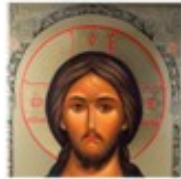
**WRITING AND READING**

Children will be completing our own version of the story **The Last Garden** by Rachel Ip. We will then be reading the book **Escape from Pompeii** by Christina Balit For Reading, children will continue reading the book **Cakes in Space**. Children will be developing their prediction and inference skills. The non-fiction Text is **Earth Shattering Events** by Rob-in Jacobs which links with the topic for this term.



**RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

In RE we will be learning about **celebrating Easter and Pentecost**. We will explore how the Church celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus. We will also think about how we can celebrate Jesus’ Resurrection. We will then learn about how Jesus returned to heaven and reflect on what this means to us. We will also look at the fruits of the Holy Spirit and reflect on the times when we need help from the Holy Spirit.



**FRENCH**

Our unit is **Ma Famille** and we will learning to how identify different family members.

**ART AND DESIGN**

In Art, we will focusing on **sculpture**. We will be looking at the creating art work using clay through a process called slabbing. We will be creating our own designs inspired by pottery from Pompeii and Ancient Rome.

**COMPUTING.**

The children will be learning about coding using Purple Mash software and programmes.

**PSHE**

We will be continuing with our focus on growth mindset and in Mindup learning about expressing gratitude and performing acts of kindness. We will also have our SRE lessons focusing on safe and secure friendships

**HISTORY - GEOGRAPHY**

**Ancient Rome**—Children will explore the life of an Ancient Roman, making comparisons between Roman life and 21st Century. We will also be researching the early settlers of Rome and the devastating effect of Mount Vesuvius on the civilisation at that time. In geography—we will be looking at volcanoes and earthquakes.
