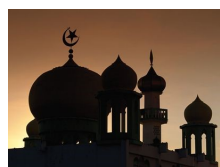
MATHS

This term, the class will be learning a variety of mathematical skills and knowledge.

- To consolidate naming 2D and 3D shapes and visualise and use everyday positional language.
- Introduce the standard units of measure and investigate problems involving weight and capacity.
- Solve number problems involving number facts.
- Solve simple practical problems in the context of money, introducing notes.
- Use understanding of place value to solve missing

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE we will be focusing on the topic Dialogue and Encounter. In this branch the children will listen to passages from the bible, retell bible



stories in their own words, know the sequence of Jesus' life death and resurrection
The children will also learn about **ISLAM** in world faiths week.

COMPUTING Purple Mash

Coding 1.7 - Children will be introduced to coding. They will predict and create their own codes. Creating a programme.

GEOGRAPHY

Our topic this half term is '**Splendid Skies** and we will be learning about how climate differs around the world and the impact of climate change. Children will look at maps, atlases and globes, ask geographical inquiring questions and carry out fieldwork to investigate.

LIFESAVERS

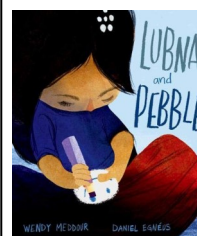
The children will be describing the way money makes them feel. They will begin to understand the consequences of losing money or having it stolen.

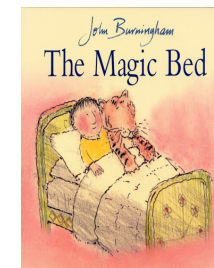
WRITING AND READING
