This term, we will be developing our athletic skills as we prepare for Sports Day!

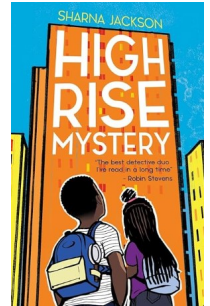


Year 5 Summer Term 2 Our climate and environment.



READING & WRITING

Throughout this term, we will be inspired by in our writing by our reading of **High Rise Mystery** by Sharna Jackson. Our main outcome will be a newspaper report, where we will apply the passive voice, figurative language, relative clauses, direct and reported speech. As we build up to this, we will create short character descriptions and setting descriptions, using high-level detective and mystery vocabulary and short sentences for impact.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION



In RE our topic is about **PEOPLE OF OTHER FAITHS**. At the beginning of term, we will be learning about **Islam** during Other Faiths Week, where we will be focusing on how Muslims believe in one God and in pilgrimage. Thereafter, we will learn about what the Catholic Church teaches about other faiths and we will reflect on what the teaching of the Church means for us, our faith and our lives.



MUSIC

This term we will be learning about **Music and Cartoons**. We will be looking at the theme song pink Panther, compose to meet certain criteria, change sounds or organise them differently to change the effect, choose the most appropriate tempo for a piece of music. Improvise melodic and rhythmic phrases as part of a group and create own skit accompanied by the music.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND HEALTH EDUCATION

In PHSE this term, we will be continuing our MindUP Curriculum, exploring issues around friendships and taking care of ourselves. We will also continue our learning about finances with Life Savers. Also this term, we will be learning about Alcohol and Drugs.

COMPUTING

In computing this term we will be learning how to create networks and models on Purple Mash.

SCIENCE

This term in Science, we are very lucky in year 5 to have experts from ClimateEd join us to explore climate change and the environment; as well as how we can take action to protect our planet. Alongside, these workshops, we will consolidate the Science we have covered this year in Year 5.



DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

In Design and Technology this term, we will be evaluating, planning and preparing a healthy and nutritious vegetable soup and flatbreads.



MATHS

This term, the class will be consolidating a variety of mathematical concepts, including:

- Mixed numbers and improper fractions.
- Rounding decimal numbers to two decimal places.
- Understanding percentages and record as fractions and decimals.
- Mental multiplication and division and problem solving involving decimals and money.
- Calculate perimeter and areas of composite shapes using formula in words and standard unit for square.
- Reading and using bus tables, graphs and charts

GEOGRAPHY

This term, we will be carrying out an independent geographical enquiry in our local area and will develop key geographical skills such as data collection, planning a route, analysing and finally presenting data. Throughout this unit, we will expand our geographical knowledge of the United Kingdom.
