



Dear Parents and Carers,

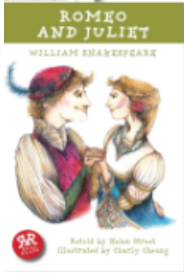

WRITING AND READING

MUSIC

MATHS

Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco Education. This term our learning will include getting ready for secondary transfer, and dealing with transition and new beginnings.

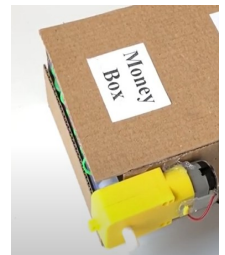
SCIENCE
